## May 2 event at United Nations building in New York attracts 160

Through statistics, case studies and anecdotes, the speakers stressed the importance of world trade as a major force to promote world communication, understanding and peace. And they endorsed the WTCA's continuing and successful efforts to spread peace and stability through trade.
